Mission Helps in Action - We Got It Done!

Earlier this year, a twelve-man volunteer team led by John Holderbaum traveled to a remote mountain town in Guatemala to assist Hope International Missions in constructing a new church. A previous crew had already completed the block walls, and the Mission Helps team took it from there —fabricating and installing steel trusses, securing them in place, and putting on the metal roofing. Thanks to their efforts, the church building is now fully "dried in," allowing the local congregation to handle the interior finishing of the sanctuary. In addition to roofing work, the team also fabricated and installed attractive steel railing, supported by sturdy steel pillars, along the outer edge of the church's elevated walkway—adding both safety and beauty to the structure. The congregation was so delighted and deeply grateful for the gift of service this devoted crew of men brought to them.
